Bellevue City Councilmember Jennifer Robertson is pleased to announce that the Municipal League of King County has rated her “Outstanding” which is its highest candidate rating.

“I am honored that the Municipal League recognizes my skills and expertise as the best fit for the Bellevue City Council,” said Robertson. “Every year I strive to protect and strengthen our community and earning an “Outstanding” from such a well-respected organization is a testament to my commitment to our beautiful city.”

The King County Municipal League is a highly regarded King County candidate interviewer. Candidates are awarded ratings ranging from “Not Qualified” to “Outstanding.” Only candidates who the League feel are path-finding, respected leaders in their communities and who bring knowledge and creativity to issues facing their office are awarded the highest rating of “Outstanding.”
